Who We Are

Brookstone Schools is a K-5 faith-based school of excellence located in the economically depressed area of west Charlotte, NC. It was founded in 2001 under the direction of civic leaders in the community to holistically address the needs of inner city students. The school relies on the generosity of volunteers and contributors to advance its mission.

Vision

The vision of Brookstone Schools is to ensure that the lives of its students will be transformed with a desire for excellence and a heart for the future of their community; and to eventually expand its program from prekindergarten through eighth grade.

Mission

The mission of Brookstone Schools is to glorify God by equipping urban students spiritually, academically, and socially for lives of future leadership and service.

Academic achievements

Achievement scores show that Brookstone students are performing at or above grade level. Brookstone's 4th graders are performing almost three years above their grade level in math and reading on the Stanford 10, a test used nationally to determine academic achievement. Currently, 83% of the Brookstone students in middle school earned A/B Honor Roll or higher during the 2008-2009 academic year. Several earned top honors in their class.

Enrollment

Approximately 80 students are enrolled for the 2009-2010 school year.

Budget

\$640,000 for the 2009-2010 school year. Less than 8% of the budget is collected in student tuition and fees. The remainder comes from donations from individuals, foundations and churches that support Brookstone's vision.
